Perihal : Informasi Beasiswa *CrossCulture Programme*  
(CCP) di Jerman

Merujuk perihal pada pokok surat, bersama ini dengan hormat disampaikan hal-hal sebagai berikut:

1. *CrossCulture Programme (CCP) Fellowships* merupakan program beasiswa penuh bagi mahasiswa internasional melalui program magang selama 2 – 3 bulan di beberapa organisasi setempat di Jerman. Tujuan dari program beasiswa dimaksud adalah memperdalam pengetahuan bidang yang dimiliki, serta memperoleh kompetensi dan keterampilan antar budaya.
2. Program beasiswa dimaksud mendapatkan pendanaan dari *German Federal Foreign Office* (Kantor Luar Negeri Federal Jerman) yang ditujukan bagi 120 peserta terpilih dari 46 negara (*eligible countries*). Mempertimbangkan situasi pandemi saat ini, pelamar dapat memilih untuk mengikuti program secara digital atau *on-site*.
3. Sebagai bahan pertimbangan, berikut disampaikan cakupan beasiswa:
  - a. Hibah bulanan sebesar 550 euro;
  - b. Tiket pulang pergi;
  - c. Akomodasi penuh;
  - d. Tiket bulanan untuk transportasi umum lokal di tempat tinggal;
  - e. Pengembalian dana dari biaya visa yang berlaku;
  - f. Asuransi kesehatan.
4. Adapun persyaratan yang harus dipenuhi antara lain sebagai berikut:
  - a. Pelamar dapat berasal dari segala **bidang akademik** atau **latar belakang akademik**;
  - b. Berusia antara 23 dan 45 tahun pada saat melamar;
  - c. Bahasa Inggris lisan dan tulisan yang baik;
  - d. Pengalaman menjadi sukarelawan;
  - e. Pelamar dalam keadaan sehat untuk tinggal lebih lama di luar negeri;
  - f. Pelamar telah dan masih berkomitmen secara sosial dalam jangka panjang;
  - g. Dokumen yang diserahkan berupa surat motivasi, CV, surat rekomendasi dari pemberi kerja atau organisasi, dan foto.

5. Pendaftaran dilakukan secara online melalui website <https://www.ifa.de/en/fundings/ccp-fellowships/> sampai dengan tanggal 31 Januari 2022. Pelamar terpilih akan mendapatkan pemberitahuan melalui e-mail dan akan diundang untuk wawancara di Kedutaan Besar Republik Federal Jerman. Dalam kasus khusus, wawancara seleksi dapat berlangsung melalui telepon atau Skype.
6. Sehubungan dengan perihal di atas, mohon bantuan Bapak/Ibu untuk dapat menyebarluaskan informasi dimaksud ke mahasiswa, dosen, dan tenaga kependidikan di kampusnya.

With its CrossCulture Programme (CCP), ifa (Institut für Auslandsbeziehungen) is working in partnership with the Federal Foreign Office to build strong civil society networks between Germany and the rest of the world. Since 2005, young professionals from the fields of culture, education, science, arts and media have benefitted from the opportunities provided by work-related stays, either in Germany or in CCP partner countries.

### **STRENGTHENING CIVIL SOCIETY**

The *CCP Fellowships* from the CrossCulture Programme provide funding for around 90 professionals and committed volunteers from over 35 countries each year. During two to three months of practical training in host organisations in Germany or CCP partner countries, participants deepen their expertise and acquire intercultural skills. In turn, the host organisations benefit from the expertise, regional knowledge and networks of the CCP fellows. The participants then bring their experiences gained abroad into their everyday working life when they return to their home organisation. Work placements are currently being offered in the following areas: politics & society, media & culture, human rights & peace, and sustainable development. From 2019 to 2023, there will also be a focus on »Civic & Citizenship Education« and »Digital Civil Society«.



### **NETWORKING CIVIL SOCIETIES**

Civil society organisations from Germany and from a partner country of the CrossCulture Programme are supported by the *CCP Synergy* Programme to work together on a project and create a lasting network. Funding for short stays is provided to employees of the two cooperating organisations. Aims of the cooperation can be the development and expansion of joint projects, publications or events. The programme encourages the direct exchange between organisations and helps to bring together civil society actors across borders in order for them to learn from each other.

### **INTENSIFYING COLLABORATION**

*CCP Alumni* has been using travel grants and regular seminars, workshops and symposia to promote the professional development of alumni funded by the programme since 2005, helping them to build on the partnerships and networks they have established. Travel grants are available for alumni to attend conferences, work on small joint projects and undertake fact-finding missions. In addition, CCP appoints volunteer country representatives who act as contact persons in the respective countries in cooperation with alumni, the German Embassy, ifa and other interested parties. Together with the CCP, they organise alumni network meetings on topics of regional and professional interest.
